As part of **Future Fit Pathway Planning** Yr 10-12 students can apply to do a **VET (Vocational Education & Training)** course for 2025. For students in Yr 10 these are introductory VET courses that give a 'taste' of an industry area. They will also provide supporting evidence to apply for the full certificate course for Yr 11 or 12.
